CLUB OPENING IN SEPTEMBER

The 14 West Hamilton Street Clubhouse will reopen on September 7. The current plan is to resume the pre-pandemic schedule—lunch Tuesday through Friday and dinners with speakers on the second and fourth Wednesdays (no lunch on those days). - The Club will follow federal, state, and city guidance and mandates for restaurants for all in-Club gatherings.
- All members and their guests will need to be fully vaccinated, and, to the best of their knowledge, not have been in the presence of others who have COVID or tested positive for COVID for 14 days prior to the Club event. A reminder/questionnaire will be sent the day before you are expected at the clubhouse.
- Masks will be worn except when seated *and* eating or drinking.

Zoom events will continue. There are four Special Event discussions scheduled in September, and they will be Zoom only. As long as there is interest in the Noon Zooms with Hosts, they will also continue.

The Club is planning to have a new member event this fall to welcome the dozen or so members who joined during the past two years. The Club is also celebrating the life of the late Club member Julian Lapidus. The event was scheduled for September 17 but has been postponed.

During the previous year and a half, the Club successfully used Zoom to host discussions and speakers. These events were all conducted remotely. Beginning in September, the Club will also be experimenting by Zooming in-club events. The plan is to have the speaker portion of the in-club event (not the meal) available on Zoom. These "hybrid" events will enable members who are concerned about the risk of infection or have difficulty getting to the Club or navigating the Clubhouse's stairs can attend Club events without venturing to the Clubhouse. The downstairs dining room will also be set up for Zoom. If the stairs are your primary issue, the Club has you covered.
